Excerpts from minutes retracing certain moments in the club members' journey and the activities carried out.

- ❖ June 1987 - Vote to become affiliated again with the Fédération de l'Âge d'Or du Québec following the withdrawal voted in January 1979.
- ❖ Prayer before the reading of the agenda.
- ❖ Sending sympathy cards upon the death of a member.
- ❖ Monthly executive meetings and regional meetings in Saint-Hyacinthe.
- ❖ August 1987 - Distribution of an activities calendar to members.
- ❖ September 1987 – Information from the regional office that the name was M069 and that the regional organization had existed for 15 years.
- ❖ October 1987 - Commemorative plaques for couples celebrating 50 or 60 years of marriage.
- ❖ November 1987 - Collaboration with the clubs of Cowansville, Granby, Knowlton, and Frelighsburg to fill buses for organized trips.
- ❖ May 1989 – Provincial file regarding the question of whether 50-year-olds would soon be accepted on the same basis as 55-year-olds.
- ❖ October 1989 - Celebration of Grandparents' Day.
- ❖ October 1989 - The departure of certain club members to the south for the winter is acknowledged.
